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Objectives of the Capacity Development Programme

- Capacity development for Government officials (Senior & middle management level) to oversee and steer the implementation of the RE strategy in the key sectors
- Mainstreaming of RE for the convergence of the GoI schemes and programmes like Make in India, Swach Bharat and Zero Defect, Zero Effect within different ministries.
- The programme will enable key departments to develop actions and programmes which promote life cycle thinking and interventions across stages, relevant to their sectors and framework conditions

Needs Assessment of Key departments


Assessment of Training methodology and manpower requirements

Modes of Delivery

- The capacity development programme can be tailor made training needs to be catered for the selected nodal officials of the inter-departmental committee on RE and circular economy
- National programme to be hosted by Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA), New Delhi under the Niti Aayog's SAMAVESH programme (option 1).
 Regional programmes can be coordinated by SAMAVESH members.
- Combination of didactical tools, exposure visits, site visits to industries and case studies
- International exposure visit can be organized (once/ year) under the EU REI
 project as per the project budget















- Training toolkit comprises of:
 - Concept and approaches on RE and CE, indicators and targets, policy approaches
 - Best environmental practices and available techniques overview on policy tools and technical instruments to develop and achieve RE
 - Systems and organizations insights into existing national RE programs of other countries
 - Objectives and instruments to support the implementation of the RE program
 - Methodological tools and business case studies from India and other countries
